**BFA Executive Committee At-Large Representative – 1 seat

This seat is open to current BFA Assembly representatives. The ExCom AL Rep serves on the BFA Executive Committee and is also expected to attend the General Assembly, Bylaws, and Faculty Council meetings. They also participate on the selection committee for the BFA Excellence Awards and serve as members of the PAC-12 ALC representing CU Boulder. These positions serve one three-year term and are eligible for a stipend.

CU Boulder Police Department Community Oversight Review Board – 2 seats

This newly formed board has two seats for faculty that are to be elected by BFA Assembly Representatives. Group will meet monthly. CU Boulder Honor Code Advisory Board – 4 seats

Open to 4 CU Boulder faculty senate members. Term is for one year. The time commitment may vary by semester and compensated with annual stipend. Statements of interest should be sent to bfa@colorado.edu by Friday, September 10. The BFA Executive Committee selects HCAB members on Monday, September 13, 2021.

BFA members are encouraged to serve on at least one committee. Follow [this link](#) for additional information about specific committee charges, composition, etc.

Nomination e-mail packets should include:

1. the nominee's affiliation (A&S or Non-A&S), home department/unit, and contact details;
2. the specific committee(s) of interest;
3. the nominee's confirmation (separate e-mail is fine) that they are willing to serve;
4. the name and department/unit of the faculty member making the nomination (self-nominations are most welcome!);
5. an e-mail header containing the phrase "**BFA Internal Election.**"

Please e-mail your nomination packet(s) to the BFA at bfa@colorado.edu by **11:59 pm, August 31, 2021**. Shortly after the nomination window closes, you will receive an email with a link to the electronic voting site. Voting will occur from **September 2-3**. This will be a fast election so be prepared...vote early!

The election results will be posted on the BFA web page when they are available.
