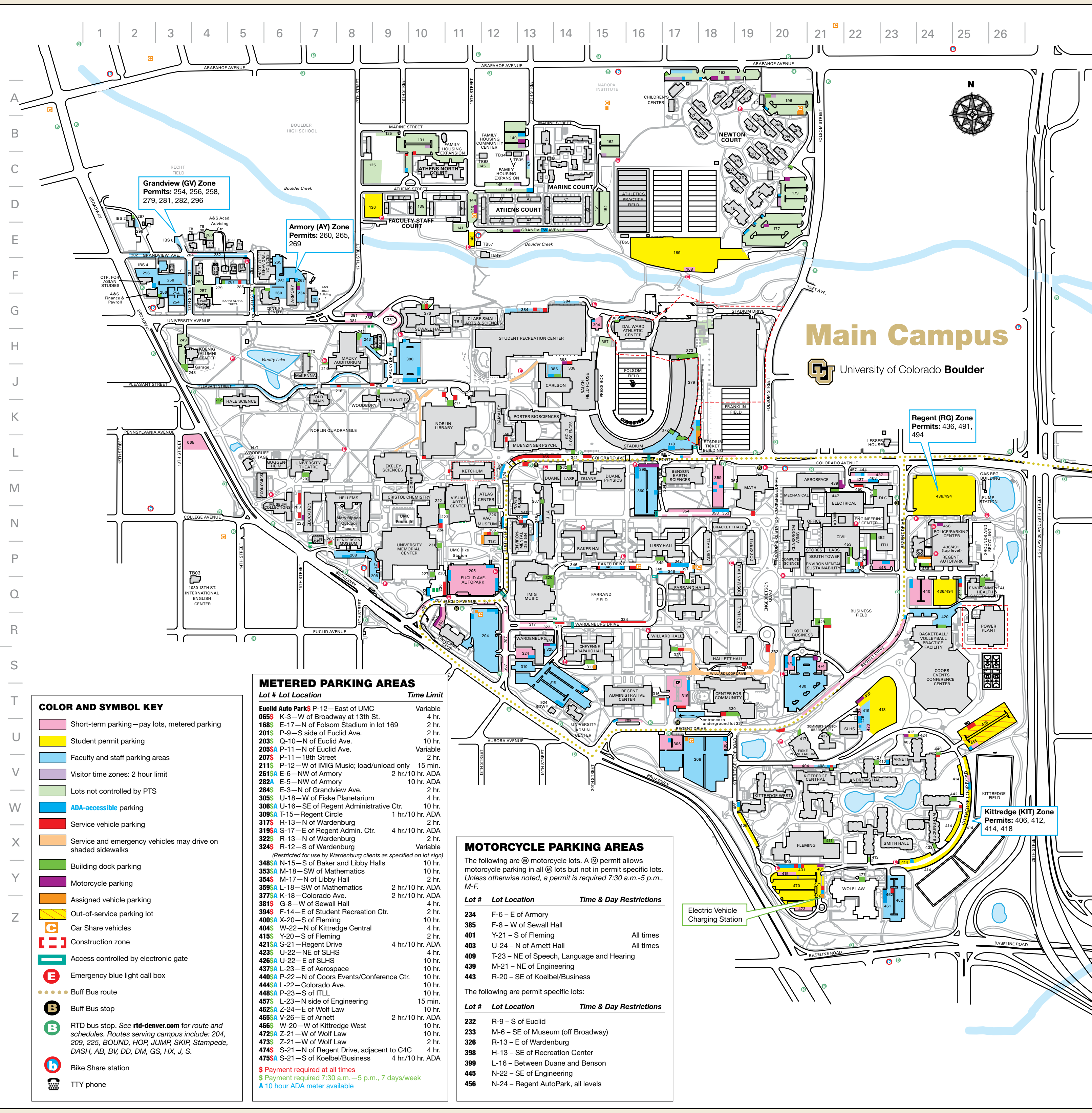

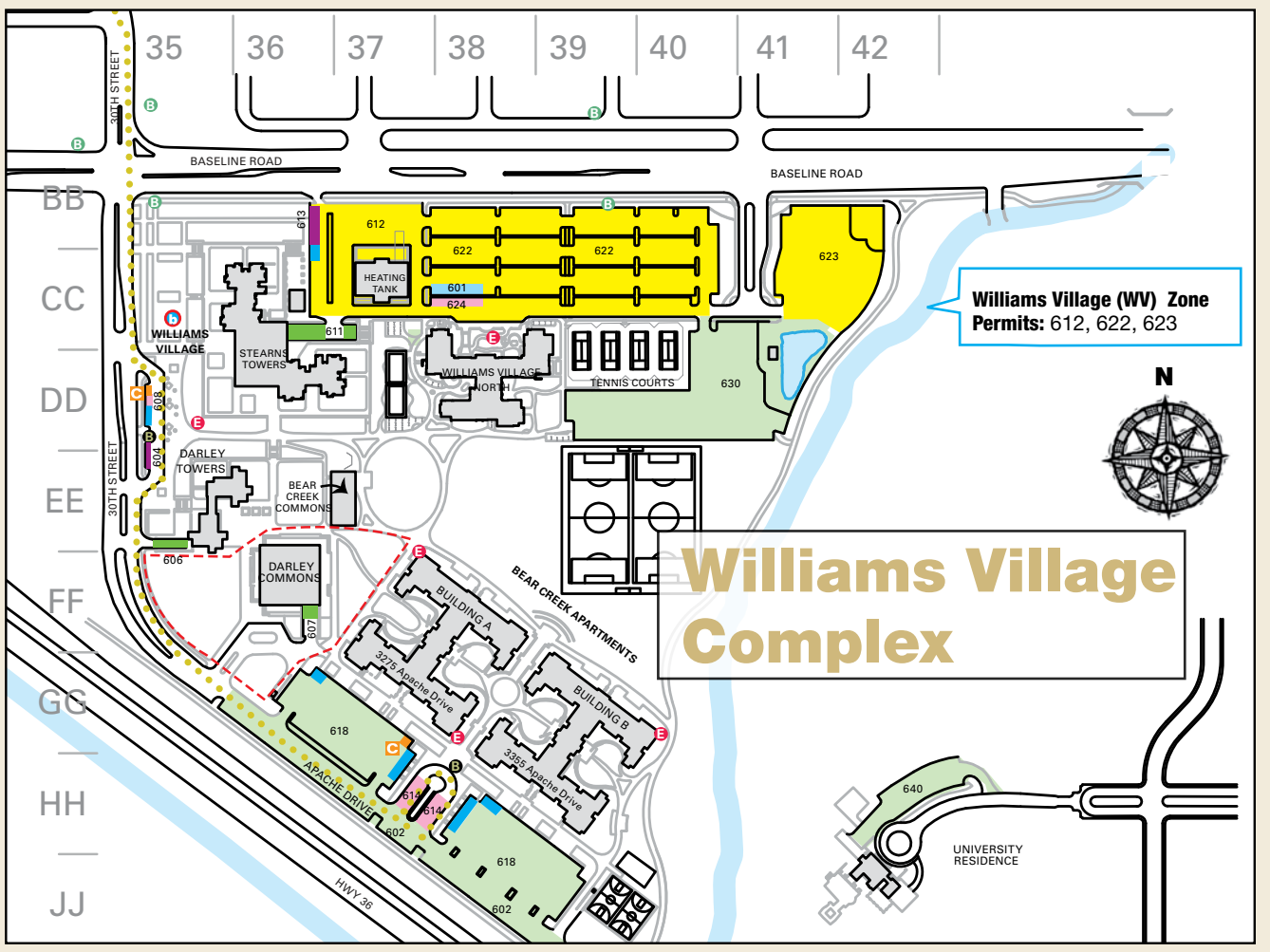
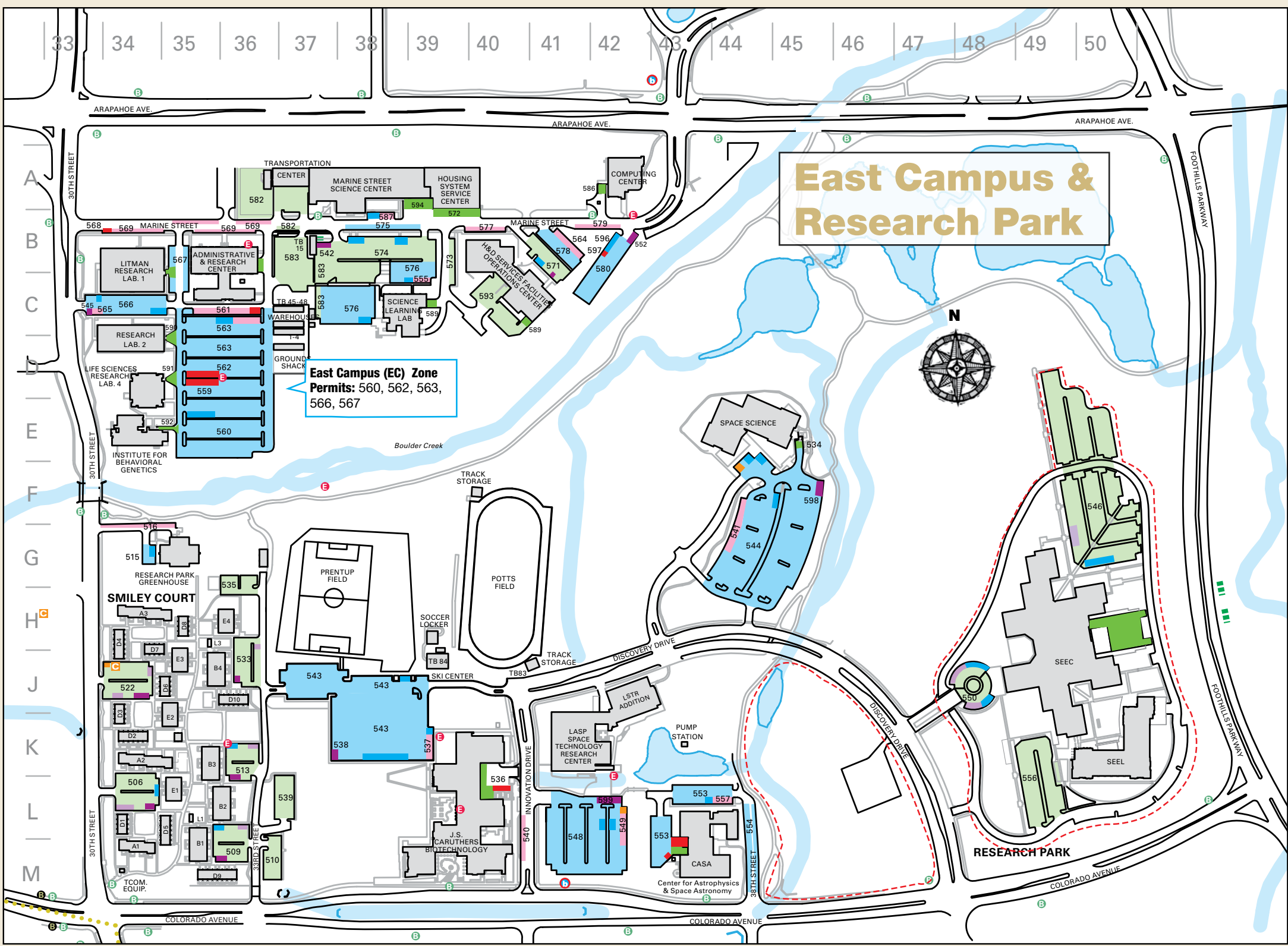

Parking and Transportation Services (PTS) develops and manages parking and optional transportation programs throughout CU-Boulder's main campus, Research Park, east campus and in the Williams Village residential area.

PARKING PERMITS

Faculty and staff obtain parking permits with the assistance of their department parking liaisons; student parking permits are available for purchase online at specified times. Personal permits must be paid for by individuals, not with university funds. Please display your permit when parking in your permitted lot, or an assigned overflow lot when your primary lot is full. Register all vehicles you will park on campus with PTS. Prorated refunds are available if you choose to return your permit. Parking permits are registered to specific license plates, and are not transferrable. On occasion when routine parking patterns are changed due to events, construction or emergencies, parking staff will provide permit holders access to a temporary parking lot.

VISITORS AND VENDORS

Visitors and vendors may purchase permits or pay at meters, pay stations or attended facilities. Short-term visitor and vendor permits are available at 1050 Regent Drive. Please check signs carefully before parking; regulations can vary by time of day or day of week.

- Parkmobile Pay by Phone:** Parkmobile allows you to pay for parking by phone at Parkmobile-enabled pay stations. When using Parkmobile you choose how long you want to park and pay for that amount of time. If registered, when the expiration time approaches you will receive a text alert allowing you to extend your time (within the maximum time limit for the lot). For more information, please visit the PTS website.

- Meters and Pay Stations:** Read all parking signs. Pay at gray and blue meters seven days a week, 7:30 a.m.–5:00 p.m. Park at blue meters only when displaying a disability placard or license plate. Many pay stations accept visitor payments between 5:00 p.m. and 7:30 a.m., when permit restrictions are not in effect during normal business hours. Display the receipt on your dashboard. Pay red meters all days and times.

- Weeknights and Weekends:** Several lots with pay stations become visitor lots from 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. weeknights, and all day Saturdays and Sundays. Pay at the pay station and display the receipt on your dashboard. Parking signs will indicate if parking lots are free from 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. weeknights, Saturdays and Sundays.

- Loading docks:** Most buildings have a loading dock where you may park free for 15 minutes while loading or unloading a vehicle. Please be careful not to block driveways or dumpsters.

UNIVERSITY HOLIDAYS

Campus parking is free on university holidays when business offices are closed. For a complete list of official CU-Boulder holidays see hr.colorado.edu/Pages/Holiday_Schedule.aspx. Please note that parking fees may be charged when a special event is held on campus during a university holiday.

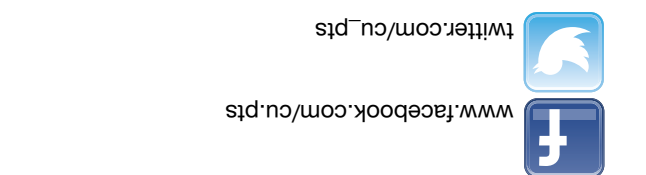

RECIPROCAL PARKING

Student, faculty, and staff permit holders from the UCCS, CU Denver and Anschutz Medical campuses may park free in CU-Boulder main campus lots 308 and 436, and in east campus lot 560 by displaying their home campus permit. Parking in other lots and at meters requires payment. CU-Boulder permit holders visiting other CU campuses may park free by displaying their valid CU-Boulder parking permits in designated lots on those campuses. For more information, visit www.colorado.edu/pts/parking-permits.

As a campus auxiliary, PTS is self-supporting. The sale of parking permits is the primary source of revenue. PTS provides a wide range of services including new and improved parking facilities, parking and traffic control for many campus events, and updating technology to improve customer convenience. CU-Boulder is granted its authority from Colorado Revised Statute 23-5-107 to create rules and regulations including but not limited to control of parking spaces, assignment of parking permits, removal of vehicles parked in violation, and assessment of fines for violations. - Read signage and park in designated parking spaces.

Be aware.

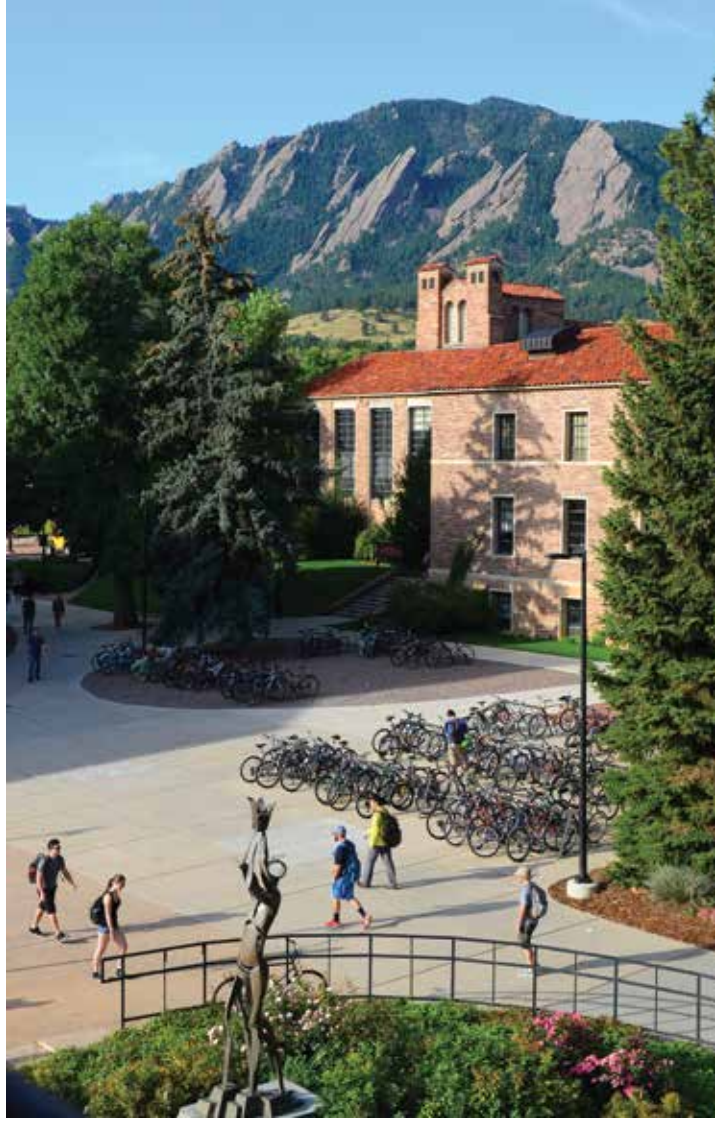
- Park only as long as needed to load or unload.
- Use service parking spaces for service vehicles when possible.
- A state-issued disability license plate, placard, decal or permit.
- Park in ADA-accessible parking spaces only if displaying a permit.
- Altering dates on temporary permits is prohibited.
- Respond to parking citations.
- Obtain a parking permit for a permit-controlled lot.

Be considerate.

- Unless you have a permit to do so, driving on campus sidewalks is prohibited and is never allowed during class changes.
- Heed posted parking signs.
- Don't block driveways, sidewalks, streets or loading docks.
