IT identity is an emerging theory that connects an individual's usage of IT to the individual's sense of self (Carter and Grover et al. 2015). This relation brings to light a new perspective of studying human-computer interaction, revealing there is an aspect of connectedness between the individual's identity and IT. There are many areas of future research required to explore the extent of IT identity's presence in society, including the social media environment (Carter, Reibenspiess, Li, and Grover et al. 2022). Specifically, IT identity has yet to be studied within social media; this is a ripe area for research considering social media is a multi-disciplinary IT, with emphasis on psychological and sociological elements. There is currently no existing literature that explains the effects of an individual's IT identity on information processing or memory recall in social media interactions. We hypothesize that, moderated by the effects of IT identity, people are more likely to remember extreme or polarized information but less likely to remember mundane middle information on social media.
