My main technique was to fill in the premade outlines through the lectures as a primer for the subject matter. Then I continually created flash cards that I quizzed myself on throughout the summer. I didn't create the one page outlines because they didn't help me to memorize the material—that's just not how I learn. I also listened to the lectures on core material that Kaplan provided as mp3s while I was working out, cleaning, driving, etc. Flash cards + listening to mp3s were the keys to helping me memorize.
