PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

<u>Review existing Capstone Resources</u> Attend one of the Capstone Partner Information Sessions and/or review our online resources <u>What is a Capstone Project?</u>, <u>Capstone Partner Guide</u>, and project briefs from past years.

Schedule a call with Alice to get your questions answered or to brainstorm a proposal

Review the proposal instructions

Optional Submit a draft proposal to Alice for feedback

Submit final proposal through our Proposal Portal by October 1, 2024

AFTER PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Be sure to check your inbox (including spam folder) for emails from our team. We may ask you to revise and resubmit during the review period (October 1-31) to increase proposal clarity or to include missing information.

Finalists advancing to the Networking Session will be notified on November 4. Note that being a finalist does not guarantee that a student team will be assigned to you. Capstone Partner selection is competitive.

NETWORKING SESSION FOR FINALISTS

The Networking Event is an in-person event, during which potential Capstone Partners and students discuss projects and form connections.
