Scales:

Two major and one chromatic scale of the player's choice, either slurred or in any slur pattern. Scales should be played in sixteenth notes with a tempo no slower than quarter note = 60. Scales should consist of the appropriate number of octaves according to the players accomplishment.

Trombone/Euphonium
