## **Album Task Sheet: Becoming a Globetrotter in Early Modern Japan**

### **Task**

Using the “Globetrotters’ Japan: Places” collection on the MIT *Visualizing Cultures* website, complete a narrated album from the perspective of your assigned character. The “Image Gallery” for the collection can be found at [http://ocw.mit.edu/ans7870/21f/21f.027/gt\\_japan\\_places/imgal\\_home.html](http://ocw.mit.edu/ans7870/21f/21f.027/gt_japan_places/imgal_home.html). The album can be created in a print format or using technology such as PowerPoint or PhotoStory. Whatever the format, the album must include the elements below:

- A title page and/or cover.
- An introduction to your album. This five- to eight-sentence paragraph should list the purpose, in your words, of your journey and describe what you have discovered about early modern Japan during your trip.
- Six to eight images that tell a story about the landscape and culture of Japan from your perspective.
- A three- to five-sentence narrative for each photograph.
- Citations for your images. Put the citations at the end of your presentation in a slide or works cited page. Your resources are limited to those available in the “Globetrotters” collection at the *Visualizing Cultures* website.

You will give an overview of your album in a five-minute presentation. Your presentation must include an overview of your album from your assigned perspective and include visual references from your album.

Your teacher will provide rubrics for the album and the presentation.
