

OJ Harvey Veteran Scholarship

The University of Colorado Boulder Veteran and Military Affairs Scholarship Committee will select the recipients based on the listed criteria for a \$5,000 general scholarship for the 2022-2023 school year, renewable for students that continue to meet requirements. Applications deadline is July 1, 2022. Because this scholarship is renewable, you do not need to reapply each year as long as you are still a current student at CU Boulder and meet the scholarship eligibility requirements.

Requirements

- 1. Honorably discharged from the military, submit member 4 DD-214 with application.
- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 3. Enrolled as an undergraduate student at CU Boulder.
- 4. Earned at least 12 credits at CU Boulder.
- 5. Completed OJ Harvey Veteran Scholarship Application.
- 6. If selected, students are required to send a thank you note to the scholarship donor.
- 7. A minimum 500 word essay explaining how you are successfully achieving academic progress and how this award would aid that progress. Essays not submitted in a Word document will not be accepted. Submit as a Word document to stewart.elliott@colorado.edu.
- 8. One Recommendation Form from CU Boulder Faculty who can address the applicant's qualifications for the scholarship. Some faculty members will send the recommendations separately.
