

VMA Veteran Scholarship

The University of Colorado Boulder Veteran and Military Affairs Scholarship Committee will select the recipients based on the listed criteria for a \$3,000 general scholarship for the 2022-2023 school year (annual, not renewable). Applications deadline is July 1, 2022.

Requirements

- 1. Honorably discharged from the military, submit DD-214 with application.
- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 3. Accepted as a degree seeking undergraduate or graduate student at CU Boulder.
- 4. Completed at least one full-time semester at CU Boulder before Fall 2022.
- 5. Completed CU Boulder VMA Scholarship Application.
- 6. If selected, students are required to send a thank you note to the scholarship donor.
- 7. A minimum 300 word essay explaining how your military experience combined with your higher education will benefit your community. Essays not submitted in a Word document will not be accepted. Submit as a Word document to lawrence.conner@colorado.edu.
- 8. One Recommendation Form from CU Boulder Faculty who can address the applicant's qualifications for the scholarship. Some faculty members will send the recommendations separately.
