

Thuet Veteran Scholarship

The University of Colorado Boulder Veteran and Military Affairs Scholarship Committee will select the recipients based on the listed criteria for a \$5,000 general scholarship for the 2022-2023 school year, (annual, not renewable). Preference will be give to Leeds School of Business students. Applications deadline is July 1, 2022.

Requirements

- 1. Honorably discharged from the military, submit member 4 DD-214 with application.
- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 3. Enrolled as an undergraduate student at CU Boulder.
- 4. Earned at least 12 credits at CU Boulder.
- 5. Completed Thuet Veteran Scholarship Application.
- 6. If selected, students are required to send a thank you note to the scholarship donor.
- 7. A minimum 500 word essay explaining how your military experience helped you be successful at CU Boulder. Essays not submitted in a Word document will not be accepted. Submit as a Word document to christopher.smith-6@colorado.edu.
- 8. One Recommendation Form from CU Boulder Faculty who can address the applicant's qualifications for the scholarship. Some faculty members will send the recommendations separately.
